Your Library Card FAQs

Q. How do I get a library card?

A. Bring in a photo ID and proof of current address.

Q. How old do I have to be to get a library card?

A. Children should be at least first grade age in order to be a part of the experience. Children under 18 must have a parent or legal guardian with them.

Q. Can I have someone else pick up my books for me?

A. Yes, they must either use your card or their own. We cannot "charge" books to someone else's card.

Q. Are there any limits?

A. Yes, there is a limit of 4 items checked out at a time for movies and music CDs. You cannot use another patron's card to check out these items.

Q. What if I forget my card?

A. We can look up your own card for \$0.25. You can replace your card for \$1.00.

Q. Where can I use my card?

A. There are over 40 libraries in our system that will accept your card. You can also have their materials sent to Hiawatha.
