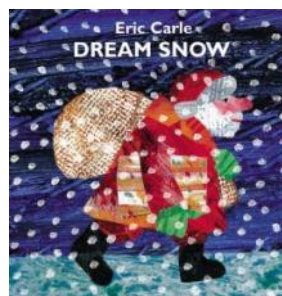


# hoopla™
